

AQUILEGIA (COLUMBINE)

Location: Zone 3, sun to part shade, moist, well-drained soil

Shape: Graceful, elegant clump or mound

Foliage: Green, lacy

Flowers: Spring

Notes: Distinguished by leaflets arranged in groups of two or three and unique spurred flowers that are highly attractive to hummingbirds. Uses include rock gardens, shady borders or masses along walks or drives.
