

ECHINACEA (CONEFLOWER)

Location: Zone 3-4, sun to light shade

Shape: Upright

Foliage: Medium to dark green

Flowers: Summer

Notes: Echinacea are long blooming, long lived, heat and drought tolerant plants. The leaves are normally hairy with a rough texture. The common name comes from the characteristic “cone” at the center of the flower.
