

GENTSCH WHITE HEMLOCK

Tsuga canadensis 'Gentsch White'

Height: 2-4' **Spread:** 3-5'

Location: Zone 4, sun to light shade

Shape: Dense mound

Foliage: Creamy white

Notes: This Canadian or eastern hemlock cultivar is a globose, dwarf, evergreen conifer. The needles at the branch tips are silver white, thus giving this shrub the appearance of being covered with snow. Annual shearing promotes fresh new color and helps maintain the compact form.



MOON FROST HEMLOCK

Tsuga canadensis Moon Frost'

Height: 3' **Spread:** 3'

Location: Zone 4, sun to shade

Shape: Dwarf, mounded to globose

Foliage: Green, whitish new growth

Notes: Bright white new growth, reminiscent of the glow of frost on a moonlit night. Older green inner foliage retains light tones giving the plant an overall whitish appearance. In winter, the white foliage is blushed with pink. A reliable small dwarf conifer.
