

# HYDRANGEA TREES

*Hydrangea paniculata*

## Limelight

Bright, lime-green flowers add a much needed brightness to the late summer landscape. In autumn the blooms display shades of pink, burgundy and green. Excellent vigor and floriferous blooming. Flowers on new wood so it can be pruned in winter or early spring.



## PeeGee

Blooms in July and August with very showy, large conical white flowers which change to pink bronze towards autumn. The flower heads dry easily when cut, and are perfect for use in arrangements.



## Pink Diamond

Pink Diamond has incredibly large cream flowers that gradually turn to a rich shade of pink. Trained on a standard, this tree-form hydrangea is a beautiful focal point in any border.



## Quickfire

Now available in tree form. Quick to bloom, a month earlier than other varieties. Will flower in late May or early June depending on your location. The flowers will turn a deep pink. A terrific way to extend the hydrangea season.



## Tardiva

Late Panicle Hydrangea, trained to a single stem with a head, blooms in late August with showy white flowers which age to a lovely mauve pink. The flower heads are more open than PeeGee Hydrangea, resulting in an elegant, airy, showy floral display.
