

NORTHERN RED OAK

Quercus rubra borealis

Height: 60-80' **Spread:** 40-50'

Location: Zone 4, sun

Shape: Pyramidal to round crown

Foliage: Dark green, red to bronze in fall

Notes: The fastest growing Oak and one of the easiest to transplant, this tree is great for street use or as a landscape tree. The foliage is dense and lustrous and leaves hang on the tree into winter. Named the 1999 Iowa Tree of the Year.
