

RUDBECKIA (BLACK EYED SUSAN)

Location: Zone 3, sun, heat and drought tolerant

Shape: Upright

Foliage: Green, rough textured

Flowers: Late summer to fall

Notes: Tough, long blooming perennial that are easy to establish. They have a daisy-like flower with gold petals and a dark center seed head. The foliage on Rudbeckia is scratchy and hairy.
